Whereas, Late S.D.Singh, husband of the Founder shared the growing concern with progressive delinking of Education from values even though Man and Society are believed to hinge on Values and the Society conceived and developed Education to transmit and transform Values to perpetuate itself as also to sustain the social change process,

AND

Whereas, he believed that the traditional educational technology " Teaching Methodology of Education" has proved grossly inadequate to transmit and transform Values and, as such, there is an urgent need for adopting " Learning Methodology of Education" particularly to impart values-based, Socio-nation oriented and eco-friendly education to unfold a

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wholesome personality of the growing children radiating with socio-ecological and human values with which alone they can face the challenges of the 21st Century and attain a socio-ecological niche in the fast emerging industrial society and biologically shorn technological civilisation.

And

whereas, the Tata Iron and Steel Company Ltd, has made available a building premises with a campus on a piece and parcel of land measuring more or less 2.812 Acres in Sidhgora, Agrico, Jamshedpur on a monthly lease rent basis to open and manage an English Medium School.

And

whereas, in the fond memory of her husband, the Founder is desirous of establishing a non-proprietary educational trust "S.D.Singh Memorial Educational Foundation" having registered office at Uliyan House, S.D.Singh Path, Kadma, Jamshedpur 831 005 hereinafter referred to as the Foundation with initial contribution, of Rs. 5,000/- only to organise and manage the school for promotion of values-based education particularly with emphasis on Social Harmony and National Integration

And

whereas, the Trustees have agreed to carry out the trust herein created.

It is now hereby agreed as follows ::

1. OBJECTIVES OF THE FOUNDATION :

(a) to organise and manage a public School (both for boys and girls) to impart values based and eco-friendly education and unfold a wholesome personality of the

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growing children to be able to face the challenges of life.

- (b) to adopt the school as a Pilot project for research, experiments and demonstration in values-based and eco-friendly education.
- (c) to undertake and execute historical, creative and policy related research projects in the field of education.
- (d) to conduct survey of the "Operative Values System" of the teaching community and to develop strategy of intervention for their transformation into "Perceived Values System" through pragmatically conceived and systematically designed orientation Courses.
- (e) to organise and conduct Orientation Courses for the teaching faculty of schools and Colleges in Values Education.
- (f) to organise and offer courses that are considered critically important for restoring and sustaining perceived values system like Courses in Journalism, Teacher's Training, Population Education, continuing education, Adult Education, Environmental Education, National Integration, etc.
- (g) to offer consultancy service in the spheres of Curriculum Designing, developing, Model of Teachers-Students Integration, Module of Campus Activities, Effectant Organisational culture considered conducive to values-based and eco-friendly education.

2. DECLARATION OF THE TRUST ::

The founder with the consent of the Company has

delivered all that building premises with the campus made available by the Tata Iron and Steel Company Ltd, on a monthly lease rent basis in Sidhgona, Agrico Jamshedpur for the purposes of organising and managing an English Medium School along with initial contribution of Rs. 5,000/- only to the Trustees to hold the same unto and to use of the Trustees upon the trust, and with under the subject to the powers and provisions herein contained.

3. POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ::

To attain the aims and objectives of the Foundation and to sustain its programmes and activities, the Board of Trustees shall have powers to

- acquire by gift, lease/licence, purchase or otherwise any property-moveable and immovable- that may be considered necessary for promotion and furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Foundation.
- Construct, alter improve, maintain and develop its buildings as and when necessary and feasible.
- raise, manage, utilise and invest funds of the Foundation in the best interests of the Foundation keeping in view its aims and objectives.
- receive grants, subscription, donation, deposits and fees for furthering and maintaining the programmes and activities of the Foundation.
- Publish Books, Journals, Handouts, Research Evidences relating to the thrust areas of the Foundation.
- establish and manage a Desk Top Publishing (DTP)

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and /or a printing press to cater to needs of the Foundation as also the growing needs of similar Organisations and Institutions.

- Employ such officers and office staff(s) as may be considered necessary for organising, managing and administering the programmes and activities of the Foundation on such salary or salaries as the Board of Trustees may think fit and suitable and also remove/ replace them as and when the Board of Trustees consider it necessary and desirable.
- Co-operate and collaborate with Organisations and Societies/ Trusts engaged in similar programmes and activities,
- Undertake all such activities and programmes that are considered necessary, desirable and conducive to furtherance of the aims and objectives of the Foundation

5. RELATION OF THE FOUNDATION WITH THE SCHOOL :

Accepting the critical role that the Foundation shall have to play in providing an organisational culture and creating a congenial environment in the school to achieve the cherished goals as also generating a work culture to enable the teaching faculty to impart quality education values based and eco-friendly-and help the school to project itself as the centre for Educational Excellence, the Board of Trustees shall

- Ensure that the school is provided with adequate building, furniture, equipments and qualified staff as per the norms of the affiliating Board
- ensure that the school is organised, managed and administered essentially as a Community service,

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- ensure that the revenue generated from the School is utilised on the maintenance and development of the School,
- exercise control over the School Managing Committee and approve the Budget including Tuition Fees and annual Charges of the School,
- exercise control over capital expenditures on land, construction of building and its expansion, and purchase of major equipments for the School.
- Generate funds to meet the recurring and nonrecurring expenditures of the school.
- ensure that the school has the basic essential infrastructure and facilities such as Laboratory Equipments for Games and Sports, and other Co-curricular activities, Library Books, Computer System, etc.
- constitute Selection committee/Departmental Promotion Committee for various categories of staff,
- lay down Service conditions of various categories of employees and approve promotion/appointment/termination of the employees as well as grant special increments or rewards to the staff,
- ensure that the school functions as per the norms laid down by the affiliating Board and take all necessary steps to provide quality education to the students of the School.
- appoint a Manager/Correspondent who will function as an important and necessary link between the Foundation and the school- he will ensure that the directives from the Foundation are conveyed to the School Managing

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Committee and to the Head of the Institution- he will exercise general supervision over the School subject to the control of the Managing Committee - he will exercise such financial powers as may be delegated to him by the Foundation- he will sign the letters of appointment/ disciplinary actions/ termination/ suspension, etc on behalf of the School Managing Committee he will also countersign all letters relating to affiliation/ recognition.

6. FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS OF THE FOUNDATION ::

CHAIRMAN :

- (a) Diwakar Singh, Trustee is Serial No. 1 shall be the Chairman of the foundation.
- (b) He shall preside over all the meetings of the Board of Trustees and shall exercise overall supervision and control over the affairs of the Foundation.
- (c) He shall exercise his casting vote in case a motion is put to vote and the result of voting results in a tie.
- (d) He shall convene the first meeting of the Board of Trustees wherein the Secretary and the Treasurer shall be elected.
- (e) He shall convene a meeting of the Board of Trustees even after advice of the Chairman .

SECRETARY :

- (a) The Secretary shall be executive officer of the Foundation and shall be responsible for execution of all the decisions of the Foundation.
- (b) He shall be responsible for maintenance and safe

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custody of all the records of the Foundation.

(c) He shall convene all meetings of the Board of Trustees in consultation with the Chairman and shall maintain proceedings/ minutes of all the meetings of the Board of Trustees.

(d) He shall exercise general supervision and control over working of the office of the Foundation and the Staff working therein. He shall sign all appointment letters for the office staff appointed on the recommendations of the selection committee constituted by the Chairman.

(e) He shall perform all such acts and deeds that may be entrusted/ assigned to him by the Chairman or the Board of Trustees.

TREASURER :

(a) The Treasurer shall be responsible for proper maintenance of the books of accounts of the Foundation.

(b) He shall be responsible for the safe custody of the Cheque Books of the Foundation.

(c) He shall be responsible to get the Annual Accounts of Foundation audited by a firm of Chartered Accountants appointed by the Board of Trustees and place the audited accounts in the subsequent meeting of the Board of Trustees for discussion and approval.

7. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ::

(a) The Board of trustees shall ordinarily meet at least four times within one year preferably once in every three months for disposal of the business of the Foundation.

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(b) One-third of the trustees of the Board of Trustees shall form the quorum for the meeting of the Board of Trustees.

(c) An adjourned meeting of the Board of trustees shall not need the quorum.

(d) Notice of the meeting of the Board of Trustees along with the Agenda detailing the business to be transacted in the meeting shall be circulated at least seven days before the date of the meeting.

(e) An emergent meeting of the Board of Trustees may be convened by the secretary in consultation with the Chairman by circulating the notice of the meeting at least three days prior to the date of the meeting.

8. TERMINATION OF TRUSTEESHIP :

(a) Trusteeship of a person shall stand terminated by resignation, death, criminal prosecution, lunacy, moral turpitude, insolvency, activities prejudicial to the interests of the foundation or by a resolution of the Board of Trustees in a meeting presided over by the Chairman.

(b) The trusteeship shall stand automatically terminated on failure of attending consecutive four meetings by any trustee.

(c) The vacancy caused in the Board of Trustees by the termination of trusteeship shall be filled in by the remaining trustees in a meeting of the Board of trustees presided over by the Chairman.

9. BANK ACCOUNT :

(a) A Bank Account in the name of the Foundation shall

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be opened in any of the nationalised banks into which all money received by the Foundation shall be regularly deposited and it shall be operated by the Chairman with either the Secretary or the Treasurer or any other trustee so authorised by the Board of Trustees.

(b) Money lying in the Bank Account unlikely to be utilised for a reasonably long period may be placed in a term Deposit or invested in Fairly safe securities yielding high rate of interest.

10. MAINTENANCE OF ACCOUNTS AND THEIR AUDIT :

The accounts of the Foundation shall be properly maintained and shall be audited every year by a competent Chartered Accountants appointed by the Board of Trustees.

11. PROCEEDINGS :

All proceedings by or against the Foundation shall be filed in the name of the Foundation through its Secretary or any other trustee of the Foundation so authorised by its Board of Trustees. The trustees shall in no case, be liable for any loss to the foundation unless the trustee(s) are guilty of fraud.

12. REVERSION OF FOUNDATION PROPERTY :

Since Foundation is a public trust, the property of the Foundation shall, in no case, revert back to the founder or her descendants or any other person. No portion of the fund of the Foundation or the income there from shall be utilised on any other objects or purpose than of the foundation hereby created and established.
